

# AG FAQs

## FOR ENROLLMENT

### How do I enroll my child in Almighty Gymnastics?

- Check the schedule on the gymnastics page.
- Check for availability by contacting us through email at [ag@fbcba.org](mailto:ag@fbcba.org) or reach us at 918.317.2259
- Provide your child's first and last name, date of birth, email and phone number. With that information we can secure your spot on the roll.
- When your class is confirmed, a waiver form will be sent to your email and you must fill it out before showing up to class.

### When does gymnastics enrollment start?

- Enrollment is ongoing throughout the year. Check out our calendar on the gymnastics page for the classes programmed for the year.

### Is switching to another class possible?

### What is the cost for gymnastics?

- There is a one-time registration fee of \$15 per child.
- Monthly tuition is \$60. If you start in the middle of a month, your tuition will be prorated for that month.
- If you have more than 2 children enrolled, any additional sibling will receive discounted tuition at \$30/month.

### How do I make a payment?

- Once you enroll, we will send an invoice to your email through FreshBooks, and you can make your payment by clicking on the invoice and entering your card information. There is an option to save your card for recurring payments.
- Monthly tuition is sent out the first week of the month automatically for the rest of the season:
  - Fall season: From August through November
  - Spring season: From January through May

### Is the credit card stored forever?

- No. Once you start the season and you choose to save your card on file, it will save through the rest of that season. If you participate in the following season, you will have to save your card again for automated payments after making your first payment.

## **ABOUT THE GYMNASTICS PROGRAM:**

### **What kind of gymnastics program do you offer?**

- We are a recreational, non-competitive, Christ-centered program.
- We don't have all events equipment for competitive gymnastics such as vault or 12x12 floor, uneven bars or high beams, but we have the right equipment to offer variety and skill progressions in a safe and clean environment.
- We instruct gymnastics and tumbling from an entry level program to an equivalent 3rd to 4th level program.
- We don't do competitions with other gyms, but we do offer a Parent Observation Day at the end of the Fall semester.
- Our coaches are experienced on the level they instruct and we carry a program of skills progressions throughout the season.
- We have devotions and prayers at the end of the class.
- We have a rewards system for good listening and obedience.

### **What to wear for gymnastics classes?**

- Active sportswear is fine, leotards for girls are preferred, and you may add shorts or leggings if you desire.
- Please style the hair out of the way of the face and arms to prevent the children from stepping on their own hair when doing handstands, bridges and other specific skills.

### **Where is the gymnastics area located?**

- The entrance is at the GYM on the Northside of First Baptist Church Broken Arrow.
- The gymnastics room is next to the basketball court.

### **Which class would be the best for my child if he or she has not done gymnastics before?**

- If your child is 7-years-old and up and has never done gymnastics, he or she can start at Basic Tumbling and will be paired with others at the beginner level. We divide within the class into different levels and the coaches will assess and work according to their ability.
- If your child is younger than 7, he or she will be introduced into their age group class and moved up when he or she ages out and ready based on skill and maturity.

**When can my child move up to the next level/class?**

- When your child is young, coaches can keep track of the age, maturity and coordination skill progress. Coaches assess constantly, and will let you know when your child is ready to move up. If you haven't had feedback after a while, please contact your coach directly.
- In order to move to the advanced class, one must perform certain skills as prerequisites you may be enrolled in the class.
- Coaches must approve before children move up to another class.

**Are there make-up classes?**

- Make-up classes are announced only after closing for inclement weather or special events that cause us to close the facility. Otherwise, we don't offer make-up classes for missed days.

**Do you offer private classes?**

- Currently, we don't offer private classes, but we typically offer Cartwheel and Back Handspring clinics about three times per semester. Dates will be announced during the first month of each season.
