

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)



How do I enroll my child?

- 1. Visit our schedule
- 2. Contact us to check availability:
 - o Email: ag@fbcba.org
 - o Call: 918.317.2259
- 3. Provide your child's full name, date of birth, your phone number, and email
- 4. Tell us your preferred schedule and a second choice as well.
- 5. Once confirmed, we'll send you a waiver form to complete before attending class.

When does enrollment open?

Enrollment is open year-round. Check our <u>calendar</u>

Can I switch to another class?

Yes, depending on availability. Contact us by email or phone.

What does it cost?

- One-time registration fee: \$30 per child
- Monthly tuition: \$70 (prorated if starting mid-month)
- Discount: 50% off for each additional child after the second

How do I pay?

- You'll receive an invoice via email through FreshBooks.
- Pay securely by card (option to save for auto-pay).
- Invoices are sent the first week of each month for:
 - o Fall Semester: August-November
 - Spring Semester: January–May

Is my credit card saved permanently?

No. It stays on file only for the current semester. You'll re-enter it if enrolling in a new semester.

What if I need to drop out?

Y ABOUT THE PROGRAM

What type of program is this?

We are a recreational, non-competitive, Christ-centered gymnastics program. We focus on skill development, fun, and spiritual growth.

What equipment do you use?

While we don't have competition equipment (e.g., vaults, 12x12 floor, high beams), we provide safe, clean, and progressive training equipment.

What levels do you teach?

From beginner to advanced (roughly level 3-4). We do not participate in competitions but do offer Parent Observation Day at the end of the fall semester and a Showcase at the end of spring semester.

What else happens in class?

Each session ends with devotions and prayer. We also have a reward system for listening and respectful behavior.

What should my child wear?

- Girls: Leotards are preferred (with optional shorts or leggings)
- Boys: Active sportswear
- Hair: Pulled away from face and neck for safety

Where is the gym located?

Our entrance is on the north side of First Baptist Church Broken Arrow, inside the gym. The gymnastics room is next to the basketball court.

Which class is right for a beginner?

- Age 7+: Basic Tumbling (students are grouped by level in class)
- Under 7: Age-based class, with promotion based on age and skill readiness

How does my child move up a level?

Coaches observe maturity and skill progression throughout the season. If you haven't received feedback, contact your coach. Advanced classes require mastery of specific skills.

Do you offer make-up classes?

Only when we cancel due to weather or facility events. Otherwise, we don't offer

make-ups for missed classes.

Are private classes available?

We do not offer private classes at this time, but we do hold Cartwheel and Back Handspring Clinics about 3 times per semester. Dates are announced early each term.
